

Preamble:- Rules in force for admission to the Post-SSC and Post-HSC Diploma Courses in Engineering, Technology, Pharmacy, Architecture, HMCT etc. in Government, Government aided, Autonomous and Unaided Private Polytechnics/Institutes in Maharashtra through Government Resolutions in reference 1,2 & 3 above were proposed to be reviewed in accordance with in force policies of the Technical Education of the state and as announced by All India Council of Technical Education, New Delhi from time to time. The review proposal in this regard was submitted by the Directorate of Technical Education, Mumbai to the Government vide letters in reference 4 & 5.

Resolution:- It was under consideration to frame the eligibility criteria and the rules for admission to the Post-SSC and Post-HSC Diploma courses in Engineering, Technology, Pharmacy, Architecture, HMCT etc. in Government, Government aided, Autonomous and Unaided Private Polytechnics/Institutes in Maharashtra for the current academic year 2009-10. The Government hereby approves the rules and eligibility conditions for the admissions to the Post-SSC and Post-HSC Diploma Courses in these institutes as prescribed in the brochures attached with this resolution.(Appendix A & B)

The Centralised Admission Process (CAP) shall be conducted for admission to the first year of diploma courses in non- Government unaided institutions opting for CAP along with that for Government, aided, autonomous institutions in the state. The marks of



sport allotted to the students by Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education in the SSC mark sheet of the students shall be taken into consideration for preparing merit list for admissions to the Post-SSC Diploma courses.

The Director, Technical Education, Mumbai should ensure that these rules are properly published, circulated to all the concerned institutes in Maharashtra and also to the related Government offices before the commencement of admission process to these courses for the current academic year. The merit lists of the institutes for this academic year shall be approved as per the provisions of these rules.
